It has been said that the Origin Of Humpty Dumpty is that he really was a powerful cannon during the English Civil War (1642-49). It was mounted on top of St. Mary's at the Wall Church in Colchester, defending the city against siege in the summer of 1648. The church tower was hit by the enemy and the top of the tower was blown off, sending "Humpty" tumbling to the ground. Naturally the King's men tried to mend him but in vain.
